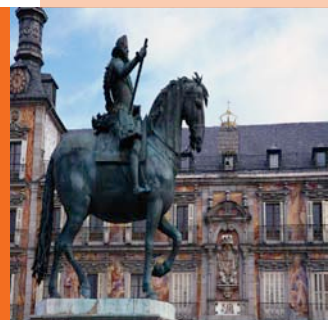

| Toledo            | A fascinating monumental city that was once the centre of the Visigoth reign, an Imperial capital and a residence of Moors, Jews and Christians. El Greco's adopted town has some of his masterpieces. This city is declared a World Heritage City.                                                                     |
| Segovia           | Also declared a World Heritage City, its impressive Roman aqueduct, the majestic Alcazar castle, the Cathedral and numerous churches are attractions not to be missed. La Granja de San Ildefonso is a lovely palace with gardens and monumental fountains, located only 11 km from Segovia.                            |
| Alcalá de Henares | Declared a World Heritage City. Alcalá is an old city only a short distance from Madrid. It is known to be the home of the famous University de Alcalá de Heneres which was founded in 1499 by Cardenal Cisneros.                                                                                                       |
| Aranjuez          | Poised on a fertile plain bathed by the Tagus River, this royal retreat boasts beautiful jewels such as the Palacio Real (Royal Palace) and the magnificent gardens which surround it. It has been a residence of kings since the 15th century. In the 17th century the Bourbon kings built the palace and its gardens. |
| El Escorial       | It is a historical residence of the king of Spain. It is one of the Spanish royal sites and functions as a monastery, royal palace, museum and school. Philip II ordered the construction of this palace-monastery, the biggest symbol of the old Spanish Empire.                                                       |

## Going out

## The Art Route

A guided visit to the most important museums in Madrid (Museo del Prado, Reina Sofía, Thyssen-Bornemisza).

The Museo del Prado features one of the world's finest collections of European art, from the 12th century to the early 19th century, which is based on the former Spanish Royal Collection. Founded as a museum of paintings and sculpture, it also contains important collections of more than 5,000 drawings, 2,000 prints, 1,000 coins and medals, and almost 2,000 decorative objects and works of art. Sculpture is represented by more than 700 works and by a smaller number of sculptural fragments. It is one of the most visited sites in Madrid.

The Museo Nacional Centro de Arte Reina Sofía is the official name of Spain's national museum of 20th century art. The museum is mainly dedicated to Spanish art. Highlights of the museum include excellent collections of Spain's two greatest 20th century masters, Pablo Picasso and Salvador Dalí. Certainly the most famous masterpiece in the museum is Picasso's great painting Guernica.

The Thyssen-Bornemisza Museum is an art gallery in close proximity to the Prado Museum. It fills the historical gaps in its counterparts' collections: in the Prado's case, this includes Italian primitives and works from the English, Dutch and German schools, while in the case of the Reina Sofía the Thyssen-Bornemisza collection, once the second largest private collection in the world after the British Royal Collection, includes Impressionists, Expressionists, and European and American paintings from the second half of the 20th century, with over 1,600 paintings.

## Breakfast & Daily Meals with the Teacher

An important part of each day is the Breakfast & Daily Meals with the Teacher, taken at a variety of restaurants in Madrid. This provides a more relaxed environment in which you can work with the language in a less formal setting.

Prices may vary depending on the restaurant. This activity is organized upon students' demand.

## Night of Flamenco

Why not book a flamenco show during your stay in Madrid? You can sit back and relax with a glass of Spanish wine or make a night of it by enjoying a traditional Spanish meal.

Madrid boasts several legendary places where the art of flamenco flourishes all year long. The "tablaos" are popular restaurants where people can enjoy live shows to the sound of the famous flamenco guitars.

Prices may vary depending on the show and tablao. This activity is organized upon students' demand.

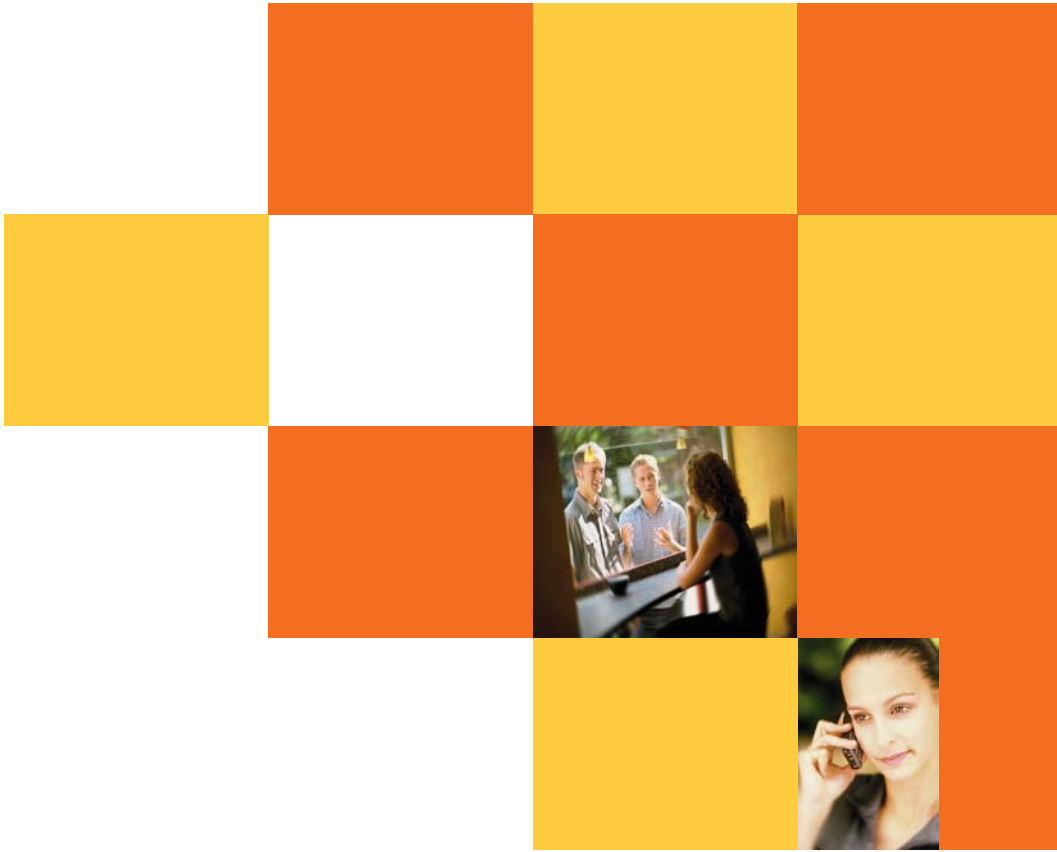
